Kasetsart University Announcement

Regarding Hygiene and Safety Measures to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19

Despite vigorous world-wide efforts, the COVID-19 virus is not yet under control. Unfortunately, the number of affected persons is continuing to rise, in Thailand and in many other regions of the world.

Kasetsart University takes these matters seriously and seeks to do all it can to protect our community, as well as others with whom we may come into contact. Therefore, we urge all faculties, departments, institutions and offices to adhere to the following measures in order to prevent the spread of the COVID-19.

- 1. Provide adequate hygienic cleansers, such as alcohol gel, in public and high-traffic areas, such as building entrances, elevators, meeting rooms, classrooms, libraries, and cafeterias;
- 2. Provide frequent and intensive hygienic cleaning practices, particularly on surfaces touched by many people, such as at building entrances, inside elevators, around washroom basins and faucets, toilet areas and floors, and frequently use anti-microbial cleaning detergent to sanitize areas often touched by numerous people, such as elevator buttons, stair railings, doorway and cabinet handles or knobs, counter-tops of service areas, library tables, etc.;
- 3. Ensure optimal maintenance of ventilation system;
- 4. Post announcements to raise awareness regarding good practice to prevent the spread of COVID-19;
- 5. Avoid activities or large gatherings of students, staff, or the general public;
- 6. Request students, staff, food service providers to follow the precaution measures and hygienic practices: remind everyone to frequently use soap and water or alcohol gel and to wash hands regularly; not to touch their eyes, nose, or mouth; wearing a face mask particularly when in public areas; and avoid contact with others, especially people who are coughing or sneezing.
